Happy New Year from the Willmar Rotary Club! It's hard to believe that Rockin' Robbins 2024 is just six months away! We are so proud of this annual event, and with your help, we are truly making a difference in the Willmar area. Proceeds from our 2023 Rockin' Robbins Concert Series netted over \$78,000, and although our first three weeks were cut short by rain, fans showed up in FORCE for Week 4, making it our biggest crowd ever! The excitement continues as we look ahead to 2024.

Since 2016, the Willmar Rotary Club has now raised nearly a half million dollars from proceeds at Rockin' Robbins. Plans for the permanent concert stage are well underway, and our club has officially pledged \$250,000 to see it through. This will be a unique dual-purpose stage with a large front-facing venue for events like Rockin' Robbins, and a more intimate backfacing venue for smaller events like "Movies in the Park" and community band concerts. The Willmar Rotary Club cut a check for \$100,000 for the stage project in 2023, in addition to paying for the engineering and design costs. Continued support from our sponsors and the community will help us reach our \$250,000 pledge.

Since 2016, the Willmar Rotary Club has invested over \$110,000 toward the revitalization of Robbins Island. These improvements have included the Willmar Destination Playground (\$20,000); a new landscaped entrance with a lighted sign and flagpole (\$17,000); the "Celebrate the Lights" holiday light display (\$35,000); Willmar Flags of Honor Veterans Memorial (\$20,000), and contributions to the Willmar Police Department, Willmar Parks & Rec, electrical upgrades for the sound system, the Jumbotron, and more (\$18,000).

Starting in 2022, proceeds from Rockin' Robbins have also supported other Rotary initiatives, including the Willmar Public Schools, AIM, Willmar Community Education, Willmar Area Community Foundation, the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf, Miles 4 Mentors, Shelter Box USA, and more.

Last spring, our club hosted our first ever "Reveal Party" at The Oaks to personally thank and recognize all our dedicated Presenting and Major Sponsors. After a brief update from our Rockin' Robbins steering committee, we revealed our band lineup for 2023, along with a short demo video from each band, and each week's Presenting Sponsors. With great feedback from our attendees, we've decided to host another Reveal Party to announce our 2024 band lineup, so keep an eye out for your invite!
